- More information about some of our exciting activities will be sent out closer to the date.

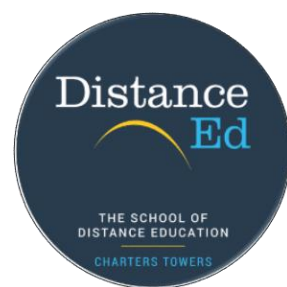
