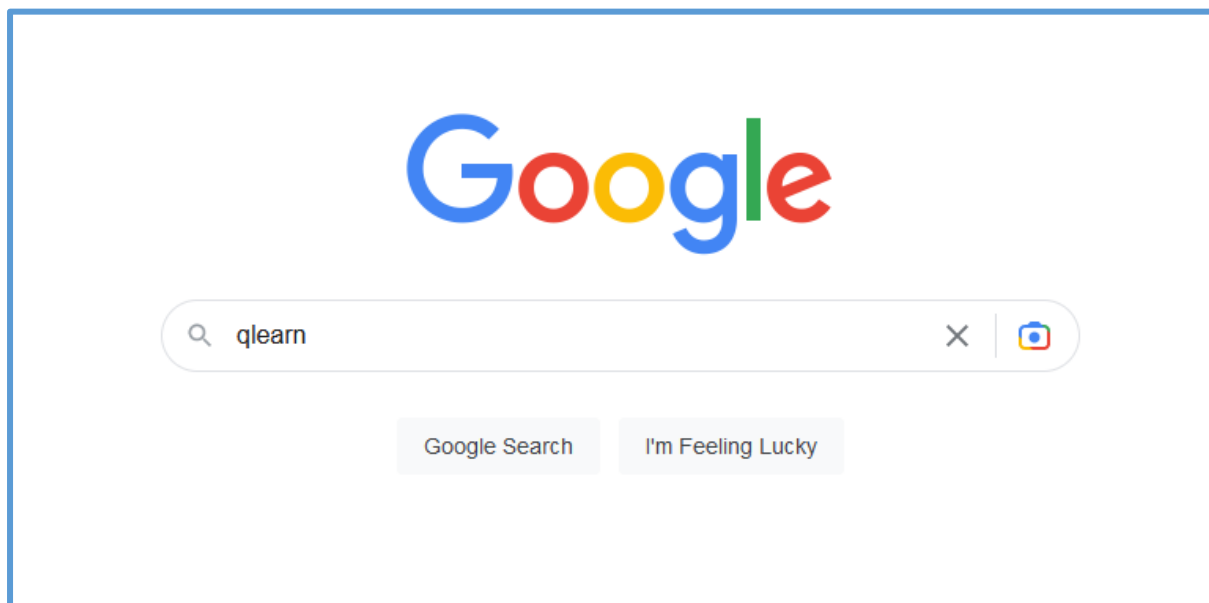
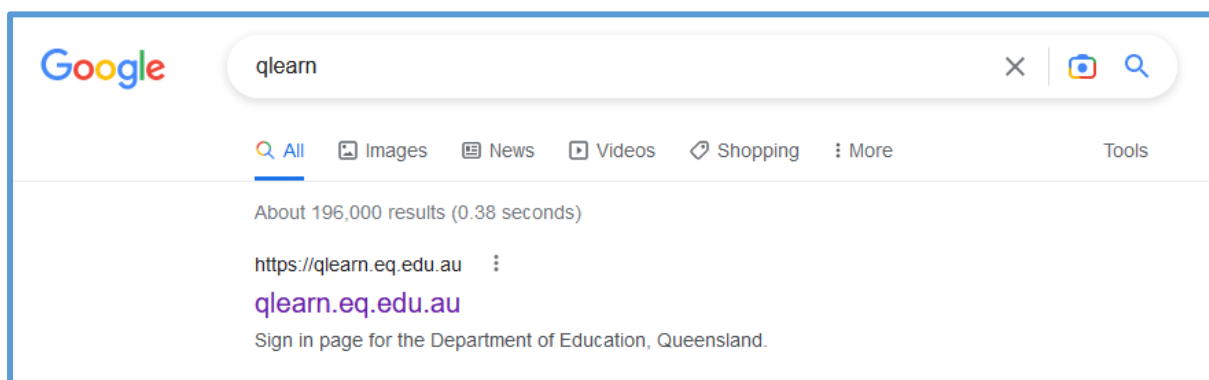


Login to Qlearn

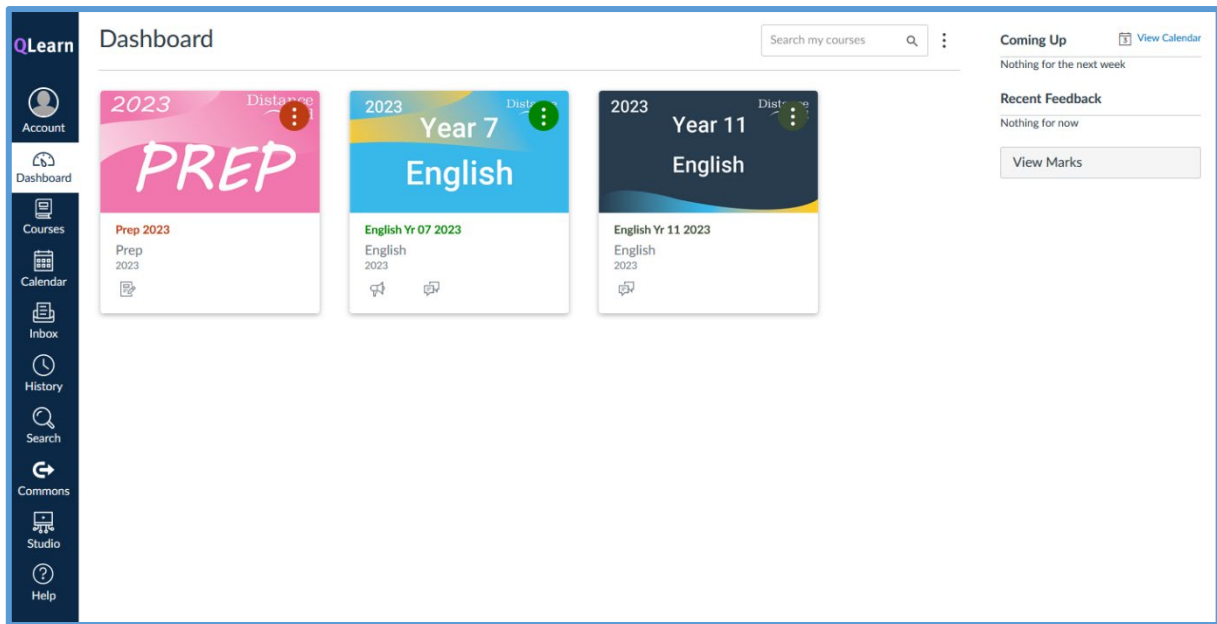

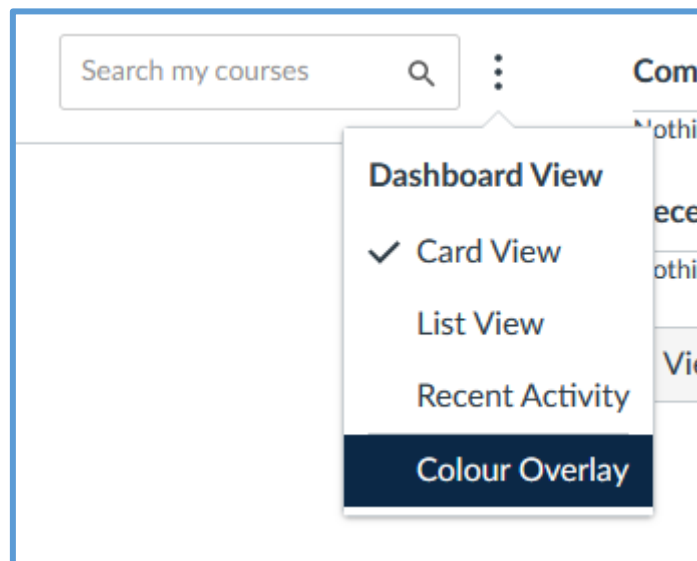
